

Preparing to join Theatre at Lambert High School?

****Class Selection date(s): January 22-30, 2026 for the 2026/2027 School Year****

Rising 9th Graders -

Sign up for your first choice of class - Advanced Drama and Competition Musical Theatre are AUDITION ONLY. You may select Advanced Drama, but based on class needs and audition assessment, you may be placed in Drama. You may select Competition Musical Theatre, but based on class needs and audition assessment, you may be placed in Advanced Musical Theatre. You will be in a theatre class if you register, however which class will be determined after auditions.

Auditions will be IN PERSON in April (See the calendar for tentative dates)

- Current students will have the opportunity to audition in class
- Rising 9th graders will need to schedule an audition - schedule sign up will be available mid-second semester, will link here.
- Current students switching tracts (from acting to musical theatre or from musical theatre to acting) will audition after school with rising 9th graders

Current Lambert students:

You will be automatically rolled-up into the next level in the series from the class you are enrolled in currently unless you opt out - students who are not currently enrolled will follow the same procedures as rising 9th graders.

ALL students (rising and current):

You will be placed in a class based on audition if an audition is required.

All theatre performance opportunities are co-curricular structurally, which means you need to be enrolled in a class to perform in a production. We are hoping to support student-produced events and productions in the future.

Every course (EXCEPT Drama I) has **mandatory afterschool rehearsals and performances**.

- Tech students are required to crew at least 1 production a year.
- Advanced Drama and Advanced Musical theatre have at least one afterschool rehearsal block leading up to a performance.
- Competition Musical theatre is the equivalent to a varsity sport - there are a minimum of two productions with afterschool rehearsal commitments and performances with additional requirements based on competitions and placement in competitions.
